What’s New with CV360-Phase II?

Project CV360-Phase II kicked off in April 2023. Since early May, the project has been in the “Technical & Functional Development Phase,” where the team is building and configuring to fit DeKalb County’s financial and procurement processes.

During the first three development cycles, the team has held over **81** demos, completed over **537** user stories, launched **4** stakeholder surveys, started building the CV360-Phase II webpage, launched the Security team, and communicated the upcoming changes to DeKalb suppliers.

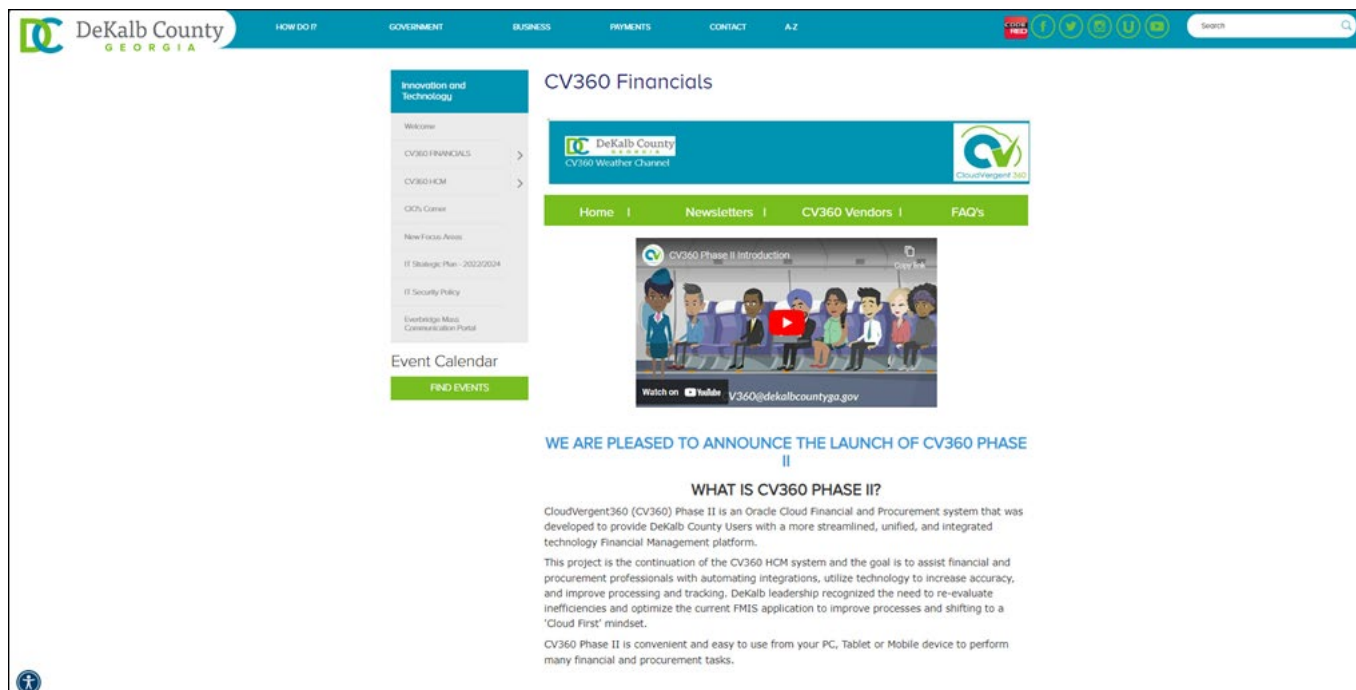
Go-Live takes place in Summer 2024. Check out the CV360-Phase II timeline below to view how the CV360-Phase II project team is tracking for a timely delivery.
