SUBJECT: Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 24-11655 *Rock Crushing Service (Annual Contract with 2 Options to Renew)*. The following questions were submitted and received pertaining to this ITB; the County's responses are as follows:

Question 1. Would the project need to be started before August 1?

- ***Answer:*** *The new contract will be effective upon the Notice to Proceed.*

Question 2. Does a bidder need a business license from his home state if a business license option is not provided by his home state (so long as a Certificate of Authority to work in Georgia is obtained)?

- ***Answer:*** *Bidders shall submit a copy of its current, valid business license with its Bid or upon award. Georgia companies are to submit a valid county or city business license. Contractors that are not Georgia companies are to provide a certificate of authority to transact business in the State of Georgia and a copy of a valid business license issued by its home jurisdiction. If Bidder holds a professional certification which is licensed by the state of Georgia, then Bidder may submit a copy of its valid professional license with Bidder's bid or upon award unless the Minimum Specifications require submittal with the bid. Any license submitted in response to this ITB shall be maintained by the Contractor for the duration of the contract.*

Question 3. Would the county consider adding in a mobilization line item into the price schedule, so that the contractor's mobilization costs are covered no matter how great or how little the tonnage of material to be crushed?

- ***Answer:*** *Mobilization cost is included in the overall crushing event. However, we would need to know your mobilization cost.*

Question 4. What date will the project begin and how long

- ***Answer:*** *New contract will be for effective upon Notice To Proceed. This contract will be for one year with two option for renewal.*

Question 5. The location or locations of the project?

□ **Answer:** Seminole Road Landfill, 4203 Clevefont Road, Ellenwood, GA

Question 6. What material is being crushed.

- **Answer:** *3” minus, finished material should be ready to be applied to our roads. Finished product should have fines without any dirt.*

Question 7. What’s the size of the material such as boulder size or anything over 24” that mat need to be

- **Answer:** *Crushing material is 24’ X 24”*

Question 8. On the bid package there is a clause stating that Dekalb will request crushing of concrete one or many times a year as needed. Our question is: Is there a minimum stablish quantity on concrete to be stock pile before the bidder is require to mobilized each time?

- **Answer:** *We have a surplus of crushable material onsite that can be processed.*
