Keep DeKalb Beautiful Hosts Post-Holiday Electronics & Shoe Recycling Extravaganza

DECATUR, Ga. – Keep DeKalb Beautiful (KDB), a unit of the DeKalb County Sanitation Division, in collaboration with the Tucker Underpass Project (TUP), will host a Post-Holiday Electronics Recycling Extravaganza on **Saturday, Jan. 10** from **9 a.m.-noon**. The event will be held at the **Northlake Mall parking lot, 4800 Briarcliff Road NE, Atlanta, GA 30345**.

The event provides participants with an opportunity to recycle used electronics, including computers, cell phones, televisions and other household appliances. Tube-type televisions will be accepted for a \$10 recycling fee and Cathode Ray Tube (CRT) monitors for a \$5 recycling fee. All other electronics may be recycled at no charge. In addition, event participants can donate gently used shoes for recycling and repurposing. IMS Electronics, the vendor performing this service, has regional offices in Lithonia.

"These programs represent KDB's commitment to promoting beautification and recycling for all communities of DeKalb County," said Keep DeKalb Beautiful Director Gordon Burkette.
