DeKalb County Announces 2015 Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday Solid Waste Collection Schedule

DECATUR, Ga. – The DeKalb County Public Works Department’s Sanitation Division announces its Martin Luther King Jr. holiday solid waste collection schedule. Due to the observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day on **Monday, Jan. 19**, garbage, recyclable items and yard trimmings for residential customers will be collected based on the following revised holiday schedule:

Monday, Jan. 19 – Martin Luther King Jr. Day observed; no sanitation collection services

Tuesday, Jan. 20 – Residential customers whose regularly scheduled solid waste collection and recycling day is Monday, Jan. 19 will be serviced on Tuesday, Jan. 20

Wednesday, Jan. 21 – Residential customers whose regularly scheduled solid waste collection and recycling day is Tuesday, Jan. 20 will be serviced on Wednesday, Jan. 21

Thursday, Jan. 22 – Normal solid waste collection services resume; residential customers whose regularly scheduled recycling day is Wednesday, Jan. 21 will be serviced on Thursday, Jan. 22

Friday, Jan. 23 – Normal solid waste collection services; residential customers whose regularly scheduled recycling day is Thursday, Jan. 22 will be serviced on Friday, Jan. 23
