DeKalb Announces Completion of Garbage Roll Cart Delivery to Monday Once-a-week Single-family Residential Customers

Tuesday customers' roll cart delivery underway

DECATUR, Ga. –The DeKalb County Sanitation Division announces the **completion of garbage roll cart delivery to Monday** once-a-week customers residing in **single-family detached homes.** Roll cart delivery to **Tuesday customers is underway,** with Wednesday and Thursday customers to follow in the upcoming weeks. Roll cart delivery to townhomes and condominiums will occur during **Phase II** of the program, which will begin in **fall 2015.**

Every single-family residential household in unincorporated DeKalb and the cities of Brookhaven, Dunwoody and Lithonia will receive a county-provided garbage roll cart. The estimated completion date for the delivery of roll carts to all customers residing in single-family detached homes is the end of August.

Once-a-week sanitation collection service began **Monday**, **July 6**, even for customers who have not yet received a county-provided garbage roll cart. Garbage, recyclable materials and yard trimmings are all collected on the same day. Reminder notices advising of customers' new collection day and literature on the service change are being delivered with each roll cart.

Roll cart delivery to single-family detached homes will mark the end of Phase I of the "Rolling Forward to One" program. More information on Phase II, with a focus on recycling, will be provided in the upcoming weeks.
