DeKalb Announces 2015 Christmas Day and 2016 New Year's Day Residential Sanitation Collection Schedule

DECATUR, Ga. – The DeKalb County Sanitation Division announces its 2015 Christmas Day and 2016 New Year's Day sanitation collection schedule. In observance of Christmas Day on **Friday, Dec. 25** and New Year's Day on **Friday, Jan. 1**, garbage, recyclable materials and yard trimmings collection for residential customers will be based on the following collection schedule:

Monday, Dec. 21 - Thursday, Dec. 24 – Residential customers will be serviced based on a normal collection schedule

Friday, Dec. 25 – Christmas Day observed; no sanitation collection service

Monday, Dec. 28 - Thursday, Dec. 31 - Residential customers will be serviced based on a normal collection schedule

Friday, Jan. 1 – New Year's Day observed; no sanitation collection service

All Sanitation Division administrative offices, including customer service, will be closed Friday, Dec. 25 and Friday, Jan. 1 in observance of the Christmas Day and New Year's Day holidays.
