If a voter cast a Republican Ballot in May, the voter may only vote a Republican Ballot in the runoff, which also includes the nonpartisan races.

If a voter cast a Democrat Ballot in May, the voter may only vote a Democrat Ballot in the runoff, which also includes the nonpartisan races.
- 

If a voter cast a Nonpartisan Ballot in May, the voter may vote either a Republican or Democrat ballot in the runoff, which also includes the nonpartisan races. The voter may also elect to vote a nonpartisan ballot containing only judicial or municipal races depending upon the voter's precinct of residence.

If a voter did not cast a ballot in May, the voter may vote either a Republican or Democratic ballot in the runoff, which also includes the nonpartisan races or a stand-alone Nonpartisan ballot.
