Cliff Valley Way Road Closure Extended Until Sept. 4 *Construction to replace sewer lines*

DECATUR, GA. – The **Cliff Valley Way Road closure** will be extended for approximately two weeks, barring any weather delays. The project requires a road closure to through traffic to continue the replacement of the water lines that are a part of the **Cliff Valley Sewer Replacement Project**.

Detour signage is installed to guide traffic along alternate routes. Motorists traveling north of 2018 Cliff Valley Way will enter and exit from the I-85 Frontage Road. Motorists traveling south of 2018 Cliff Valley Way will enter and exit the area at Briarcliff Road.

Motorists should expect delays stemming from the road closure. Precautionary signs and traffic flaggers will assist local traffic in moving safely around the road closure. Our construction crews will work diligently to minimize the length of impact to motorists.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
