



Subject: Cliff Valley Sewer Improvement Project Update: Aug. 12, 2026

Good afternoon, Residents and Business Owners:

The Cliff Valley Way **road closure** has been **extended** for approximately three weeks, until **Friday, Sept. 4**, barring any weather delays. The delay is due to the difficulty of the underground rock that must be bored through. While the road will be closed to through traffic, it will remain open to local traffic.

Detour signage will remain installed to guide traffic along alternate routes. Motorists traveling north of 2018 Cliff Valley Way will enter and exit from the I-85 Frontage Road. Motorists traveling south of 2018 Cliff Valley Way will enter and exit the area at Briarcliff Road.

Motorists should expect delays stemming from the road closure. Precautionary signs and traffic flaggers will assist local traffic in moving safely around the road closure. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected. Our construction crews will work diligently to minimize the length of impact to motorists.
