## Department of Watershed Management

### Panola Road Water Main Replacement Project

The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management is overseeing the construction of the **Panola Road Water Main Replacement Project**, expected to be completed by fall of 2026 in your community.

This serves as formal notification that the work associated with this project requires crews to replace the water pipes owned by the DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management (DWM) in your area. Crews will perform construction activities on DWM-owned pipe only and service to the water meters, typically located in the county right-of-way. Any work beyond the right-of-way, which is private property, is the responsibility of the property owner.

In most neighborhoods of DeKalb County where DWM is improving the watershed system, home builders commonly installed galvanized pipe for water services, located from the water meter to the house. This section of pipe is owned by the property owner and is not the responsibility of DWM. The life span for this pipe is typically 40 to 60 years. Please be advised that if your property is served by galvanized pipe that has aged, you will experience issues with leaks and reduced water pressure as the pipes deteriorate.

DWM suggests that residents who have galvanized pipe supplying potable water to their home should consider obtaining a professional plumber to perform any corrective work. Our construction crews will work persistently to keep you informed and complete the **Panola Road Water Main Replacement Project**.
