



Grant Drive Water Main Replacement Project Update: July 21, 2026

Greetings,

On behalf of the Grant Drive Water Main Replacement Project, we would like to report that construction activities are progressing.

While the majority of water meters have been re-established, work is still underway to complete the remaining meter installations. Once this work is complete, representatives from the contractor and the DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will conduct a street-by-street walkthrough to develop a punch list of any outstanding restoration items. The goal is to ensure that every affected yard is restored to its original condition or better.

Additional water main work also remains on Thompson Road, where approximately 200 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron pipe (DIP) will be installed to complete the connection to Drew Valley Road.

As the Grant Drive Water Main Replacement Project is nearing completion, the Grant Drive Sewer Rehabilitation Project continues. Residents may continue to see construction crews and equipment in the area as sewer rehabilitation work progresses.

The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management appreciates your patience and cooperation as these critical infrastructure improvements are completed.
