Water Infrastructure Sterilization

The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management's Office of Engineering & Construction Management Services (ECMS) has initiated a project to make improvements to the watershed system in your community.

Please be advised to expect workers in the area as the county and its contractors will need to sterilize the water pipes in your community. Residents may see water running down the street temporarily as construction crews open fire hydrants for water to purge out of the pipes. This process is called flushing and will result in better water quality.

Work in your area is scheduled to begin today and will continue over the next two weeks. Flushing is expected to last 6-8 hours each time.

Our construction crews will work diligently to minimize the length of impact to residents. Also, please note all staff working on behalf of DeKalb County will have proper identification and will drive marked
