#### Water Shutoff Notice

The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management has initiated a project to make improvements to a water distribution system in your community.

Please be advised to expect workers in the area as the county and its contractors will need to temporarily interrupt your water service to properly connect the water facilities servicing your community. Standard work hours for the project will be from 7 a.m.-7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays and unless otherwise stated.
