Sumac Water Main Replacement Project Begins October 5

DeKalb County, Ga - Efforts to improve the watershed system throughout DeKalb County continue **Monday, October 5** with the launch of the Sumac Drive Water Main Replacement Project. Crews will replace 4,200 linear feet (LF) of aging 6-inch water main with new 8-inch ductile iron pipe (DIP) and will install approximately 1,500 LF of 1.5-inch copper loop.

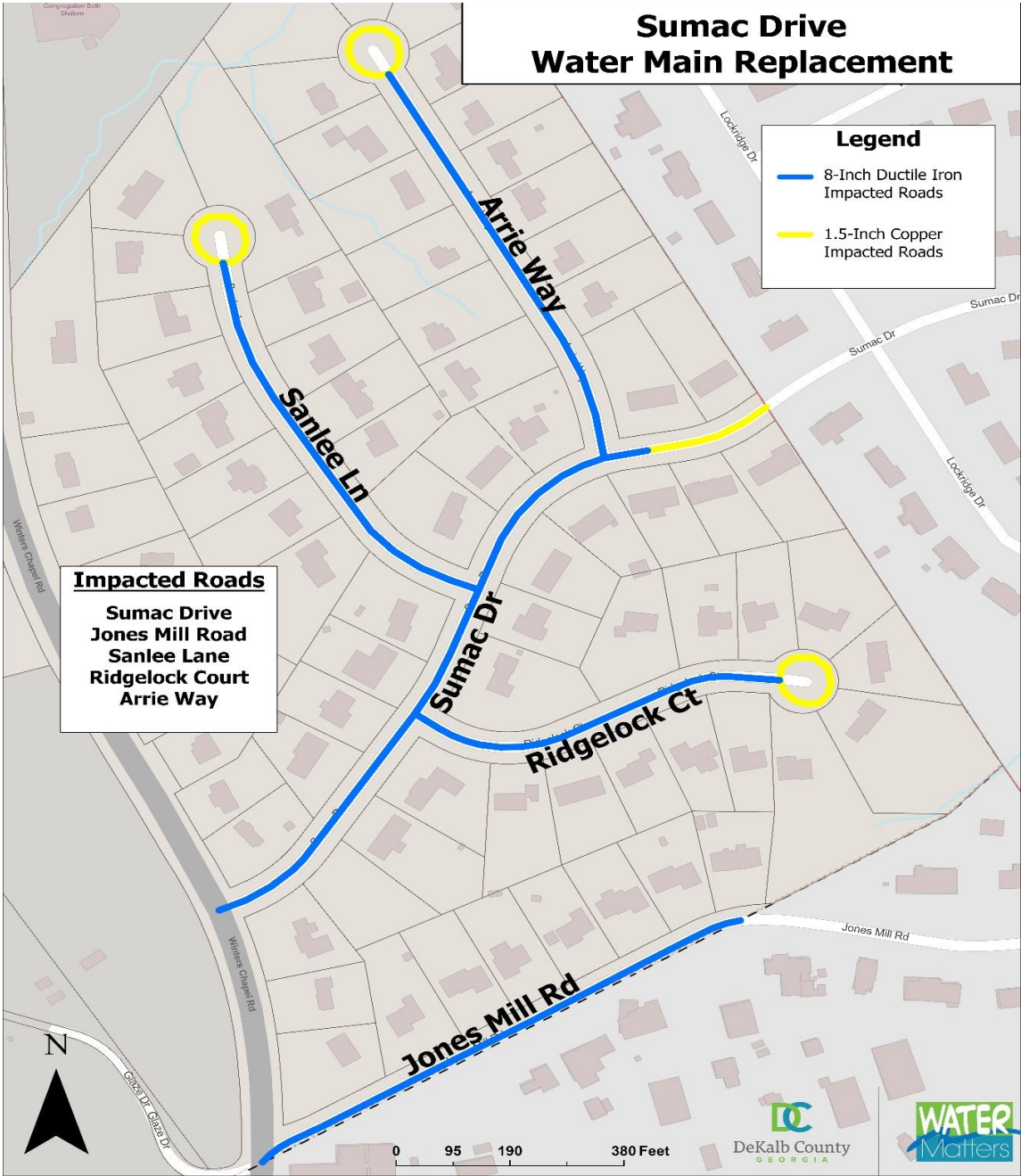
The water line repair project is expected to last approximately five months (October 2026 - February 2027), barring any weather delays.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
