As part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will be improving the capacity and service of the watershed systems serving your community. The **Shoal Creek Trunk Sewer Relief Projects Section 3B** was designed to improve the watershed system in your community.

This letter serves as formal notification that construction activities associated with this project will begin **Wednesday, Sept. 23**. A virtual community meeting about the project will be held on **Tuesday, Sept. 15 at 6:30 p.m.** via Zoom at:

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. Property owners will be notified in advance of significant changes in scheduled work hours. Please be advised to expect an **increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours**. Property owners will be notified 48 to 72 hours prior to the start of impactful construction activities. Our construction crews will work persistently to minimize the length of impact to residents.

Crews will replace 1,650 linear feet of aging pipelines in three separate locations (Conway Road, South Columbia Drive and Green Street). ***The approximate start dates are as follows: Conway Road - September 2026 to December 2026, South Columbia Drive - October 2026 to January 2027, and Green Street - April 2027 to July 2027, barring any weather or unexpected delays.***

Georgia Sewer and Storm LLC, working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the **Shoal Creek Trunk Sewer Relief Projects Section 3B**. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.
