Subject: Peachtree Boulevard Lane Closure Begins Sept. 8

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

As part of DeKalb County's \$4.27 billion capital improvement program, the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) will be improving the capacity and service of the Watershed systems serving your community.

This letter serves as formal notification that beginning on **Tuesday, Sept. 8** through **Friday, Oct. 2**, the Peachtree Boulevard southbound right turn lane onto Chamblee Dunwoody Road will be closed, barring any weather delays.

Detour signage is installed to guide traffic along alternate routes. Motorists traveling south on Peachtree Boulevard should use Ivy Lane to turn onto Chamblee Dunwoody Road. Motorists traveling west on Chamblee Dunwoody Road will continue across Peachtree Boulevard and be directed around the work area.

Normal construction hours will be from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.

Ruby-Collins, working on behalf of DeKalb County, is the authorized contractor for the **Peachtree Boulevard Water Transmission Main Replacement Project**. All workers will be wearing proper identification and driving marked vehicles.
