ADDENDUM NO. 1

ITB No. 24-101670 Fence and Gate Repair (Three (3) Year Multiyear Contract):

- 1. We have received the following questions pertaining to this ITB. The questions and the responses are below:
 - A. **Question:** Who is responsible for ensuring residential customers understand what is authorized? **Answer:** The user department will have contact with the residential customers and explain what work is authorized.
 - B. **Question:** Will we get a scope of work, or will we have to do a site visit? **Answer:** A site visit is required to determine the type of work needed for the vendor.
 - C. **Question:** How are hard dig costs handled? **Answer:** Hard dig costs are handled per occurrence and the user department and vendor will work together to determine how the project will proceed.
 - D. Question: What user departments are included in this bid?
 Answer: Public Works -Roads & Drainage; Public Works -Sanitation; Dept. of Watershed Management (DWM)
 - E. **Question:** Who is responsible for providing power within 5' for gate operators? **Answer:** The user department will be responsible for providing the power source for the gate operator.
 - F. Question: How will jobs be communicated?

Answer: Jobs will be initiated by the user department with a request for the vendor to visit the site and give the user department a quote. Once the user department approves the work, the vendor will receive a notice to proceed.

- G. **Question:** What happens if an operator is discontinued? **Answer:** Authorization will be required from the user department to purchase an updated model of gate operator, if discontinued.
- H. Question: If a cantilever gate shows signs of being hit, will it be authorized for replacement?
 Answer: The user department will inspect the gate for damage before authorization is given for replacement.

- I. Question: Was there an incumbent prior and is the scope or work the same?
 Answer: There was a prior contract. The scope of work may be similar; however, this is a repair contract, so each project has its own scope of work.
- J. **Question:** What was their contract number and amount used to execute the contract? **Answer:** Previous contract information can be obtained via Open Records Request. Instructions on how to submit a request can be found at https://www.dekalbcountyga.gov/open-records-request-purchasing.
- K. **Question:** What is your budget for this project? **Answer:** This information is not available at this time.
- L. Question: Will the contract be awarded to 1 or several contractors?

 Answer: Please refer to page 8 of the ITB solicitation, Section "C. CONTRACT AWARD".
- M. **Question:** Is bond required? **Answer:** No, a bond is not required.
- 2. All other conditions remain in full force and effect.
