## ADDENDUM NO. 2

ITB No. 24-101675 Red Dyed Diesel Fuel (Three (3) Year Multiyear Contract) is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. The bid deadline has been extended to 3:00 p.m., Monday, November 4, 2024.
- 2. We have received questions pertaining to this ITB. The questions and the resulting responses appear below:

1.	Question:	"Can you identify which locations receive Transport deliveries and which locations receive Tank Wagon deliveries?"					
	Answer:	Every location receives transport delivery except the below stations: Tank Wagon: Harmony Hills 1801 Harmony Hills Ct Lithonia, GA 30058 LCC #1 liftstation 7366 Drake Ave Lithonia, GA 30058 LCC #2 liftstation 1493 Rock Chapel Rd Lithonia, GA 30058					
2.	Question:	<i>"Are the estimated amounts for each product listed the total amount used annually or over the length of the 3 year contact?"</i>					
	Answer:	The estimated total amounts are over the course of 3 years.					
3.	Question:	"The bid lists several locations on pg. 9-10 and makes reference to 2 priority fueling stations, but only identifies one (Scott Candler Water Treatment Plant). What is the second priority fueling station, what is its address, and what are the tank sizes and locations (underground/above ground) at that station?"					
	Answer:	There is only one priority site for the Department of Watershed; Scott Candler Water Treatment Plant.					
4.	Question:	"Will you consider our bid if we no bid Tank Wagon deliveries?"					
	Answer:	Yes, you do not have to bid on all line items to be considered responsive.					
5.	Question:	"What are your office hours for bid delivery via FedEx or UPS?"					
	Answer:	Bids may be delivered to the address listed in the ITB between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm with the exception of the bid due date upon which bids must be received by 3:00 pm.					

6.	Question:	"When is the award date?"						
	Answer:	The award date will be determined once the evaluation process has been completed.						
7.	Question:	"When is the first board meeting after the opening?"						
	Answer:	At this time, the date of the first Board of Commissioner's meeting has not been determined.						
8.	Question:	"Will the decision for award be made before or at the board meeting?"						
	Answer:	The awarded vendor will be announced during the designated Board of Commissioner's meeting if the total award exceeds \$100,000.00. If the total award does not exceed \$100,000.00, the in-house award procedures will apply and the recommendation will not be heard by the Board of Commissioners.						
9.	Question:	"What is the estimated date for the start of the contract?"						
	Answer:	The County intends to issue a Notice to Proceed to the awarded vendor(s) within the first quarter of 2025. This assumes that this solicitation yields a successful bidding process.						
10.	Question:	"Can you do better than 30 days for payment terms, i.e. Net 10 or Net 15?"						
	Answer:	An answer to this question will be provided in a subsequent addendum.						
11.	Question:	"Will you accept up to 5% bio diesel in your diesel fuel?"						
	Answer:	Yes, we will accept up to 5% bio diesel fuel.						
12.	Question:	"Do you consider common carriers to be subcontractors?"						
	Answer:	Yes, common carriers are considered subcontractors.						
13.	Question:	"Will a firm fixed price be considered? If not, why?"						
	Answer:	Yes, a firm fixed price will be considered.						
14.	Question:	"What information will you be reading out loud at the bid opening?"						
	Answer:	The bid opening will include the number of bids received, along with company names of the bidders. We will also confirm if the bidders attended at least 1 of the mandatory LSBE meetings and if the price schedule was submitted in a separate, sealed envelope. Upon completion of the responsiveness evaluation, a price opening will be scheduled and costs for responsive bids will be read aloud.						
15.	Question:	"Will the Price Schedule opening be open to the public? If it is not, how and when will we be notified of the low bidder and can we receive a copy of the bid tabulations?"						
	Answer:	Yes, the price/cost opening will be open to the public. The bid tabulation will be posted to the DeKalb County website once complete.

	Answer:	Snapfinger is not a priority location, there are no diesel storage tanks there. The billing for these 9 locations will go through Snapfinger.
37.	Question:	"Page 20 PRICE SCHEDULE: Do you have to bid on both line items (transport & Tankwagon) to be considered responsive?"
	Answer:	Please refer to the answer for Question #4.
38.	Question:	"When is the anticipated performance start date for this contract?"
	Answer:	Please refer to the answer for Question #9.
39.	Question:	"Do you ever do split location transport deliveries and if so how often?"
	Answer:	Yes, it is rare but we will do it to top off diesel tanks before a storm. At most twice per year on the small tanks.
