# DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management to Host Two Community Meetings

**DECATUR, Ga.** – The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management (DWM) has launched a comprehensive, multi-phased Priority Area Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation Program (PASARP) to assess and rehabilitate sewer lines throughout the county.

These activities will encompass about one-third of DeKalb’s sewer lines. Smoke testing and other assessment activities will be conducted by contractors through January 2018.

DWM will host two more informational community meetings in February focused on PASARP activities scheduled to take place in area neighborhoods.

The informational community meetings are free and local participation is encouraged. Scheduled meeting dates and locations include:
