16. Our House, Inc. \$72,000 – Our House provides free quality childcare in a safe and nurturing environment to the children of homeless families who reside in emergency shelters or transitional housing programs. This agency also provides support services and referrals for services for the children and their families (homeless) as needed, which include, employment services and permanent housing; clothing and transportation; arranging after school care or day camp for school age children; mental health counseling; and networking with other agencies to access all other available assistance.

17. Youth Voucher Set-Aside \$75,000 – Funds will provide the opportunity for children from low to moderate income families to have meaningful summer experiences. These experiences shall be recreationally based, offer educational activities which build self-esteem, promote health, and build capacity.
