




Residential Service Notification for Noncompliance <u>OR</u> Special Collection Fees

Residential Collection Procedures



Household garbage - place in secure plastic bags prior to placing in roll cart; no loose garbage; lid must be fully closed; no excess/overflow bags on the top or side of roll carts; only county-provided roll carts are serviced.



Recyclable materials - loosely placed in roll cart; acceptable plastics - 1 and 2 ONLY; visit www.dekalbsanitation.com for acceptable materials; only county-provided roll carts are serviced.



Boxes - must be flattened (10 or less) or a special collection fee will apply



Yard trimmings – up to 5 biodegradable bags or approved containers up to 40 gallons; no plastic bags; limbs and brush must be four feet or less in length, bundled and tied; large volumes of yard trimmings, 6 or more approved yard trimmings containers or biodegradable bags, or tree parts greater than 3" require a special collection fee.



Collection day procedures - roll carts and yard trimmings containers placed curbside by 7 a.m. and removed by 7 p.m.



Bulky items - household appliances and furniture only; schedule collection at www.dekalbsanitation.com.







excess/overflow garbage bags; large volumes of garbage and yard trimmings; improperly prepared yard trimmings; tree parts; 6 or more approved yard trimmings containers or biodegradable bags; commingled piles; flattened boxes (more than 10); unflattened boxes (any number); schedule payment and collection at www.dekalbsanitation.com.



Prohibited materials - needles; batteries; dirt; rock; concrete; automobile bodies and parts; liquids of any kind; hazardous materials; tires.
