RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING PROGRAM

- Do not place hazardous materials in roll cart
- Place all items (except shredded paper) loosely in roll cart
- Place shredded paper in clear plastic bags prior to placing in roll cart
- Remove all liquids from cans and bottles prior to placing in roll cart

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Cardboard
- Packing paper (no wax)
- Paper containers and cups
- Steel and aluminum bottles/cans
- Plastics 1 & 2 (milk jugs, water bottles, juice containers, laundry detergent containers, fabric softener containers, bleach bottles, etc.; all items must have a plastic code of 1 or 2)
- Mixed paper (newspaper, magazine, copy paper, notebook, etc.)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Batteries
- Paint cans
- Light bulbs
- Electronics
- Food waste
- Medical waste
- Electrical wires
- Toner/ink cartridges
- Bubble and shrink wrap
- Construction debris or waste
- Tissue/napkins/paper towels
- Plastics 3-7 (including frozen food bags and pouches, plastic shopping bags, straws, medicine bottles, single-use plastic utensils, to-go coffee cups, take-out food containers, etc.)
