Rosewood Road Water Main Replacement Project Begins April 22
Construction to install new water main

DECATUR, Ga. – Efforts to improve water service capacity throughout DeKalb County continue on Tuesday, April 22 with the launch of the **Rosewood Road Water Main Replacement Project**. Crews will replace 16,900 linear feet of water lines with new 8-inch and 12-inch ductile iron pipe (DIP). This project is expected to last twelve months (April 2025 to March 2026), barring any weather delays.

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.

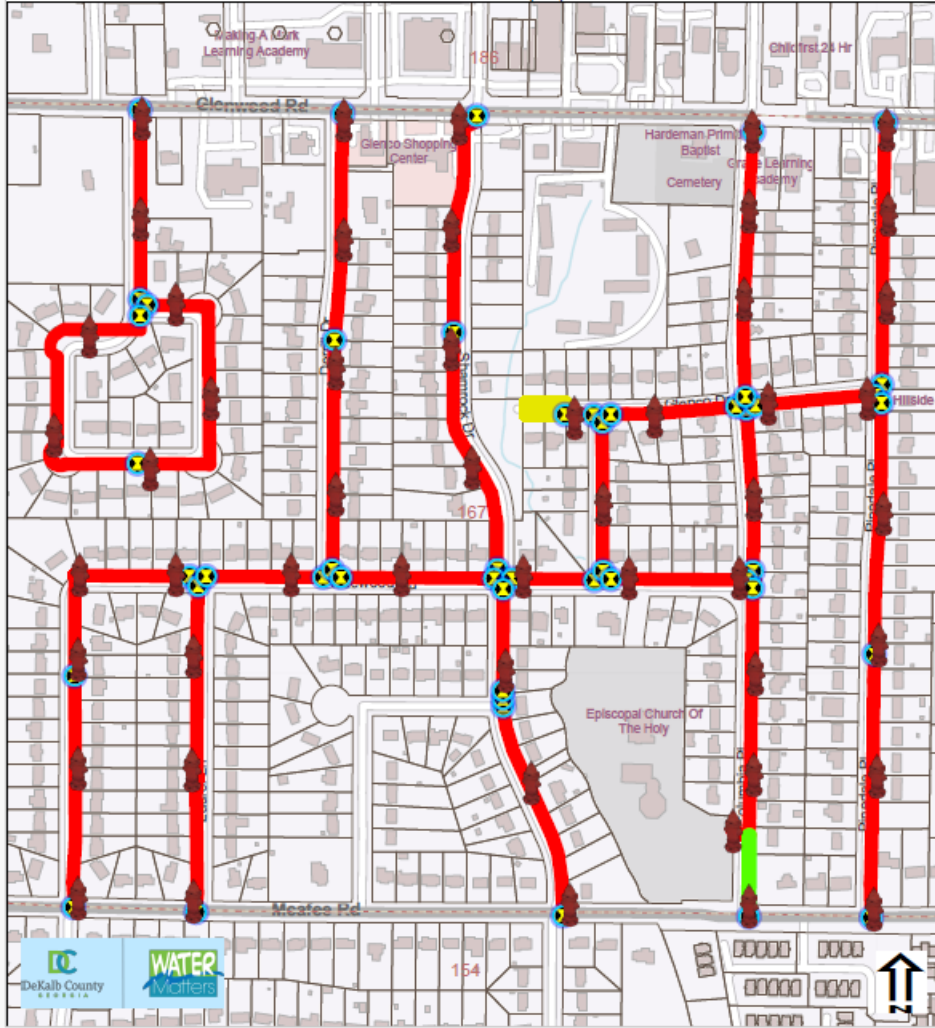
