Service Line Inspection Program



Following the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Georgia Environmental Protection Division quidelines, DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management (DWM) is currently undertaking several activities to inspect the materials of your water service lines.

- 1. During routine activities, DeKalb County DWM's technicians are inspecting and recording service line materials every day.
- 2. DeKalb County DWM's contractors are digging small test holes to uncover service line materials at select locations throughout the County.
- 3. DeKalb County DWM's requests your assistance with identifying the materials of the water pipes entering your home or building. Lookup your address and enter your information at the 'Check Your Line' link on our website at www.dekalbcountyga.gov/watershedmanagement/LCRR.

During 2025, DeKalb will begin an accelerated service line inspection program. More information will be provided as the program is developed.
