### **DeKalb Voter Registration and Elections Encourages Public Input on Proposed Precinct Boundary Changes, Polling Place Consolidations**

**[Decatur, GA]** – DeKalb County Voter Registration and Elections (DeKalb VRE) continues to seek public feedback on proposed polling place adjustments following a community meeting held on Feb. 5.

The community meeting held at DeKalb VRE offices in Decatur and at 3 satellite locations, provided voters with an opportunity to learn about potential polling site changes, ask questions, and share insights that will help shape final recommendations to the Board of Registration and Elections.

“As we work to refine our recommendations, community input remains a critical part of this process,” said Keisha Smith, executive director of DeKalb VRE. “We appreciate the engagement from our residents and encourage voters to continue sharing their feedback before any next steps are determined.”

If any changes are approved, DeKalb VRE will implement a comprehensive voter notification plan to ensure a smooth transition for affected voters.
