### SCOTT BLVD PHASE WATER REPLACEMENT PROJECT PHASE III SCOPE RECAP

Planned work includes:

- Installation of 6,000 linear feet of 30-inch transmission water main inside the right-of-way and under the existing pavement, as well as approx. 10,000 LF of 8, 12 and 16 inch distribution main.
- The existing streets will be milled and resurfaced once the new water main installation is complete. The existing 30-inch steel water main will be abandoned in place and filled with non-shrink grout.
- Tree replacement property owners will be compensated for tree replacement of a similar type tree (not size).
- Driveways will be replaced like in kind or better only to areas disturbed by the contractor or the County right-of-way




