#### Construction Notice

The DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management has initiated a project to make improvements to a water distribution system in your community.

Please be advised to expect workers in the area as the county and its contractors will need to temporarily interrupt your water service to properly repair the water line servicing your community. Residents will experience no water service for up to **12 hours** on the following day during the water line work.

Work in your area is scheduled for: **7 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 25 to 7 a.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 26.**

Standard work hours for the project will be from 7 a.m.–7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays and unless otherwise stated. Our construction crews will work diligently to minimize the length of impact to the community. Also, please note all staff working on behalf of DeKalb County will have proper identification and will drive marked contractor vehicles.
