Gravity Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement Project (Columbia Woods/Toney Drive) Begins Mar. 31

Construction to replace sewer lines and manhole structures

DECATUR, Ga. – Efforts to improve the watershed system throughout DeKalb County continue **Monday, Mar. 31**, with the launch of the Gravity Sewer Rehabilitation and Replacement Project.

Crews will replace approximately 3,091 feet of gravity sewer main between Eastwyck Drive and Saratoga Drive. *This sewer improvement project is expected to last approximately twelve months (March 2025 to March 2026), barring any weather delays.*

Normal construction hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding major holidays. An increase in construction-related noise and traffic during work hours should be expected.
